Math curriculum: The Algebra 1 curriculum was developed by the THS math teachers. There will be no published textbook. Instead, students will be responsible for maintaining a 3-ring binder with dividers containing (1) Notes and (2) Homework Assignments. There will be packets for every chapter that will be inserted into the binder, and this binder will serve as the textbook for this class. I will provide the packets and they will also be linked to the appropriate Google Classroom Assignment or Materials page.

Homework is assigned for each lesson. Unexcused late homework will generally receive half credit, and will be due by the end of each unit.

Quiz Corrections can be completed to earn back half of the originally missed points on a quiz, and they will be due the day of the test. For **Tests**, there are no test corrections allowed.

Grade Requirements: As I stated in my Back to School Welcome Letter, this is an accelerated class, and students will generally be expected to maintain an 80% or higher in this Algebra 1 class in order to move on to Geometry in 9th grade.
